

## How do I apply to do Honours in Physiology?

*To apply for Honours in Physiology, you need to complete all 3 processes listed below:*

### **1. Find a project**

You need to find a research project and supervisor to take you into their lab. At least one of your supervisors must be a member of staff or an adjunct member of staff of the Department of Physiology. You need to choose a project offered within the 2019 Physiology Honours and PHY3990 Projects Booklet. Ask the Physiology Honours Convenors for a copy or attend an Honours information session organised by the department.

### **2. Department of Physiology Honours Project Application:**

This form will be available on the Moodle sites of all 3<sup>rd</sup> year Physiology units or from the Physiology Honours Convenors. This form must be completed and submitted, regardless of whether you are applying for BSc or BMS honours (or both). It should be filled in by both you and your potential supervisors and then signed off by one of the Honours convenors. This form must be submitted to one of the honours convenors (Roger Evans, Siew Chai or Nicholas Price) by FRIDAY 16<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER\*\*.

### **3. Formal Application to Faculty:**

**For BSc honours** you should apply online through the Faculty of Science:

It is mandatory that you also complete the Physiology Department application form regardless of whether you are applying for BSc or BMS honours (see above).
