

Parking at Caulfield campus

There is a Multi Level Car park on campus (Building J – red star) with ticket machine parking available. Costs are: Up to 2 hours - \$4, 2 to 5 hours - \$8, 5 to 8 hours - \$12, All day - \$16

Meter parking for approximately 200 vehicles can be found close-by at the Victorian Amateur Turf Club (VATC) car park, situated at the Caulfield Race Course in Normanby Rd across from Caulfield Railway Station (green star), and in Sir John Monash Drive, adjacent to building T (blue star).

Please note that University parking restrictions apply at all times and infringement notices will be issued to vehicles parked illegally. Please observe signs at all times whilst on campus.

Free street parking with time limits ranging from one to five hours is available in surrounding streets, but spaces are often difficult to find.

Travelling to Caulfield campus

By car: the nine kilometres (six mile) trip from the city of Melbourne will take about 25 minutes in peak hour traffic and 15 minutes at other times. If you are coming from Melbourne airport, add another 45 minutes in peak hour and 30 minutes at other times. A taxi rank is situated on the railway station side of Sir John Monash Drive. (Melways map ref. 68 F1)

By train: Caulfield campus is opposite the Caulfield railway station which is serviced by trains going to and from Cranbourne, Dandenong, Frankston and Pakenham.

By tram: the number three tram from Swanston Street in Melbourne will take you directly to Caulfield campus.

By bus:

- Bus Route 624, between Kew and Oakleigh railway station (stops at Caulfield station)
- Bus Route 900, between Caulfield and Stud Park (travels along Wellington Road with limited stops)
