Short Bio of Speakers

DR KEVIN WHELAN

Dr Kevin Whelan is a Senior Lecturer in Nutritional Sciences in the Diabetes and Nutritional Sciences Division at King's College London and an Adjunct Associate Professor at Monash University. Dr Whelan is also a Principal Investigator leading a research programme exploring the interaction between diet, the gastrointestinal microbiota and disease. He has published extensively in the area of probiotics, prebiotics, and gastrointestinal health and disease and was a member of the *International Life Sciences Institute Expert Panel on Prebiotics*. Dr Whelan is the Associate Editor-in-Chief of the *Journal of Human Nutrition and Dietetics*.

PROF DEBRA SULLIVAN

Prof Debra Sullivan is the Chair and Midwest Dairy Professor of Clinical Nutrition in the Department of Dietetics and Nutrition, University of Kansas Medical Centre. She is also a Nutrition Consultant at the Kansas University Weight Management Program, Lawrence.

Prof Sullivan has a prolific research background, with a large number of grants and publications, primarily in the area of weight management.

ASSOC PROF KAREN WALKER

Assoc Prof Karen Walker has been teaching into the Bachelor of Nutrition and Dietetics (BND) course at Monash University for over ten years and is currently the BND(Honours) convenor.

She is an Accredited Practising Dietitian who is also an Associate Editor for *Public Health Nutrition*. She has many publications in the field of nutrition, diet and type 2 diabetes.
