

The Developmental Behaviour Checklist – Short Form DBC-P24

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Features of the DBC-P24

- The DBC-P24 is a 24-item short form of the DBC-P completed by parents or carers.
- Developed to provide a brief measure of the Total Behaviour Problem Score (TBPS) for research purposes where large numbers of questionnaires are administered. If subscale scores are required then the full DBC-P should be administered.
- The DBC-P24 has low bias and high precision in cross validation samples.
- Achieves high sensitivity and specificity to full DBC-P based caseness decisions.
