

CALL FOR nominations for the Inaugural CMHSE Emergent Educational Research Prize

Prize

\$2000 to be used to support educational research in the health professions and health sciences – to be presented on September 29 at the CMHSE Educational Research Symposium by Professor Steve Wesselingh.

Criteria for nomination

Lead researcher must be:

- Staff or student of Monash University, who is pre-doctorate (can include current doctoral students in the process of completing their candidature)¹.

Research presented in nomination must be:

- Original, completed research (ie not at proposal stage) in health science/health professional education.

Research will be judged on:

- Research design.
- Utility of findings to health professions and/or health sciences education – that is, likely contributions to innovative/improved teaching and learning experiences and/or outcomes.

¹ Core CMHSE staff are ineligible for nomination
