



Biomedical Sciences Transition Program

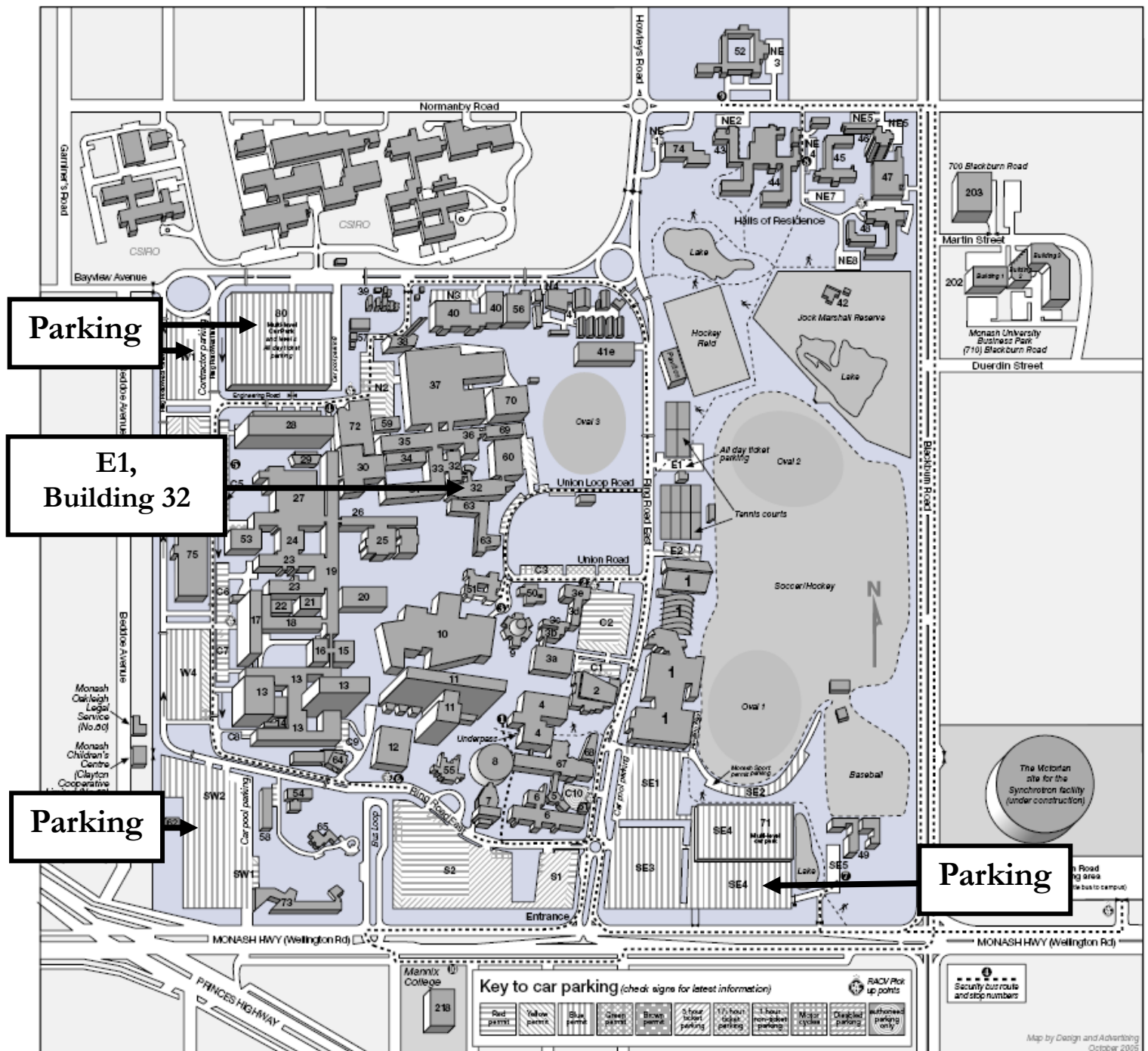


Transition Day Evening BBQ & Pub Crawl
