Admission Requirements:

Applicants must be qualified, or expect to qualify, for the award of a Bachelor of Behavioural Neuroscience degree prior to the date of enrolment for the course. To be eligible for entry into the Honours year, students should obtain a distinction grade average (70 per cent) or above in 24 points of studies in relevant units at level three. These 24 points of studies will normally include at least 18 points of units in the area of study in which they wish to undertake Honours. Students who have obtained an average of 65 to 69 in their main third-year sequence may also be eligible for consideration if they have also obtained an average of at least 65 per cent in their remaining level-three units and the relevant Head of School supports their application.

APPLICANTS PLEASE NOTE:

- Successful applicants will be required to enrol in their units prior to the commencement of Semester One 2010. Enrolment details will be provided in your conditional offer letter.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure that they have completed all requirements for their undergraduate degree.
- Applicants must be course completed from Bachelor of Behavioural Neuroscience to receive a formal offer.
