Year 4 MBBS at Gippsland Regional Clinical School

Year 4 of the Monash University Medical Course consists of students undertaking a semester of Women's and Children's Health and the other semester in General Practice and Mental Health. Students have the opportunity to undertake one or both semesters with the Gippsland Regional Clinical School in either Central Gippsland (Traralgon/Moe) or West and South Gippsland (Warragul, Leongatha and Korumburra).



You will be part of an exciting cohort of about 40 students studying across the three clinical years through our Regional Clinical School.

It is easy for your Melbourne-based friends to visit with both major training venues (Traralgon and Warragul) off the M1 Freeway. Warragul is 103 km from Melbourne and Moe (accommodation for Traralgon-based students) is 135 km, travelling on a dual carriage freeway. If they prefer to come by train there are 12 services daily.

Women's and Children's Health

The semester in Women's and Children's Health offers a broad range of clinical experience with both structured and interactive small group teaching offered by experienced clinicians as well as allied health professionals. Individual students work closely with consultants and health care teams, with the emphasis on hands-on clinical experience and learning.

General Practice / Mental Health

This semester combines extensive hands-on experience in both a GP clinic and with a mental health team with intensive small group tutorials and unique experiences within local services, such as the Fulham Correctional Centre. Our regional GPs practice comprehensive care, including some or all of obstetrics, anaesthetics, occupational health, practice management, paediatrics, minor surgery and palliative care.

You will have the opportunity to interact with a range of health professionals and work in a variety of settings in mental health. You can also participate in the integration between the GP clinic and the Mental Health Services through Primary Mental Health Teams.

Accommodation

Purpose built student accommodation is available at no cost to medical students at Warragul (5 places), Moe (12 places) and Traralgon (up to 16 places).
