In Year 5 the Monash University Medical Course consists of students undertaking a series of six-week rotations. Within the Gippsland Regional Clinical School, positions are available in each of these rotations as follows:

These rotations offer great opportunities to be involved in patient care as a part of the “treating team”. Placements in both Traralgon and Warragul also allow you to observe the activities of the interns, helping you decide if you would like to work there after graduation.

You will be part of an exciting cohort of about 40 students studying across the three clinical years through our Regional Clinical School.

It is easy for your Melbourne-based friends to visit with two of the training venues (Traralgon and Warragul) off the M1 Freeway. Warragul is 103 km and Traralgon is 155 km from Melbourne travelling on a dual carriage freeway. If they prefer to come by train there are 12 services daily. Wonthaggi is also an easy 135 km drive from Melbourne on the South Gippsland Highway.
