

**Monash University Department of Rural & Indigenous Health (MUDRIH)
Primary Health Care Research, Evaluation & Development (PHCRED) Program**

- 001. Population Health/Health Promotion Research Grant (funded up to \$7,000)**
- 002. Indigenous Health Research Grant (funded up to \$7,000)**
- 003. Interprofessional Education Research Grant (funded up to \$7,000)**

These grants aim to build research capacity and expand the knowledge-base in interprofessional education, Population Health/Health Promotion or Indigenous Health research, while at the same time providing a vehicle for the provision of new knowledge to underpin primary health care policy and practice.

Specifically the goals are to:

Promote the capacity for rural primary health care professionals to work together by developing research or research training modules to enhance interprofessional education, population health/health promotion and Indigenous health activities. Applications must be aimed at supporting research skills and capacity building of novice-early career researchers in Gippsland.

GRANT APPLICATION & PROPOSAL INFORMATION REQUIRED

1. Indicate which PHCRED Grant you are applying for.
2. Your name and contact details including email address and phone numbers.
3. Summary details of your qualifications with dates and a summary of your career development activities to date (100 word max).
4. Title of the proposed project and a 100 word summary of the proposed research project (100 word max).
5. Details of the aims, rationale, methods, location, timetable and an itemised project budget of your project (500 word max). Please list total amount requested from PHCRED and include any additional sources of funding secured or applied for.
6. Statement of how your project will improve primary health care (100 word max).
7. Statement of your career aspirations (100 word max).
8. Email addresses of two referees who can be contacted quickly to provide a reference about the benefits of this project to your professional development. Indicate briefly why you have chosen them.
9. ABN details of either the applicant or supporting organisation. If registered for GST, applicants must include GST in their budget. Applicants not registered for GST or not required to be registered for GST, need to state that in their application.

Funding will not be finalised until ethics approval (if needed) is received.
