Primary Health Care Research, Evaluation and Development (PHCRED) Program aims to build research capacity and expand the knowledge-base in primary health care, while at the same time providing a vehicle for the provision of new knowledge to underpin primary health care policy and practice.

PHCRED is offering 2 scholarship grants (up to \$1,500 each) and 2 research networks grants (up to \$1,400 each) in 2009 to support an early career primary health care researcher to advance research activities.

Scholarship Grant: Scholarships are awarded to support early career researchers to develop their research proposals under supervision. Researchers may attend short professional development courses relevant to their work, activities including clinical placements, short courses, postgraduate tertiary courses and attendance at professional conferences.

Research Networks Grant: Research networks grants are to support the establishment of regular research meetings in the Gippsland region, including Regional Clinical Schools and Divisions of General Practice. Such research networks are aimed at the development of a critical mass of researchers within each region and are a venue for collaborative meetings to take place between research workers and their clinical colleagues.

Requirements: A summary and brief details of research projects under development. Applications must be aimed at supporting research skills and capacity building of novice-early career researchers in Gippsland.
